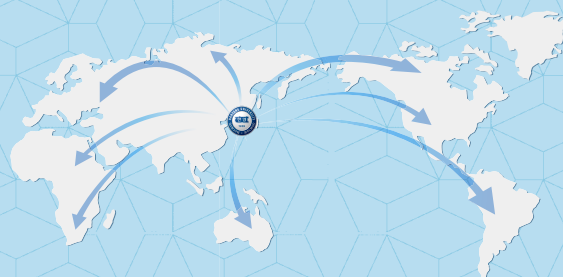

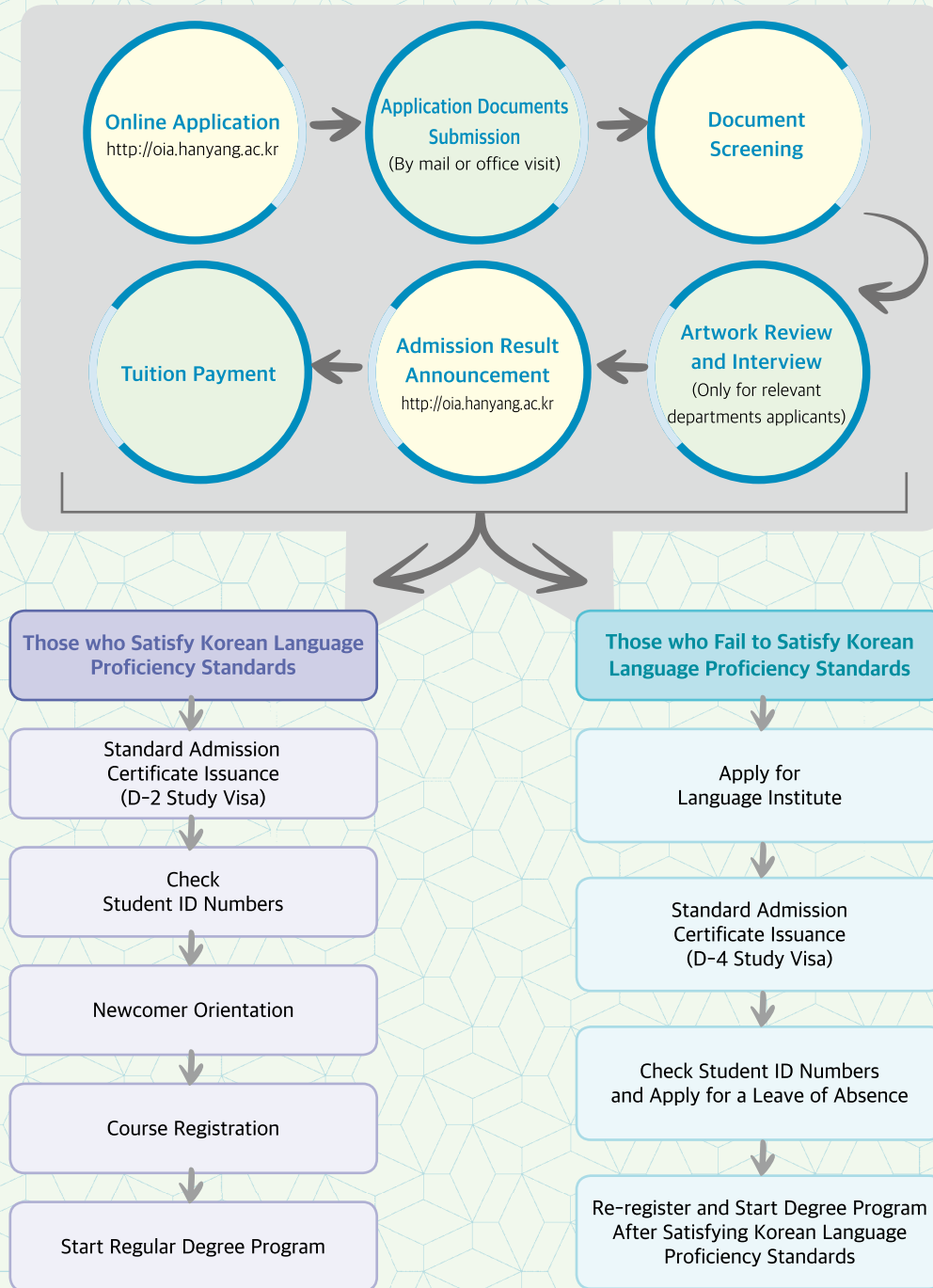

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2022 Spring Semester Application Procedure (Undergraduate, Graduate)



* Applicants' scholastic ability is prioritized when it comes to evaluation. Even the applicants who do not satisfy Korean standards can be accepted by Hanyang University based on their scholastic competence. However, these students should satisfy Korean standards to start their degree programs.

2. Dual Application Criteria

(For more information, please see page <09. Undergraduate Dual Application>.)

- Seoul Campus applicants can apply for up to two choices for dual application. However, Business Administration and Media Communication majors can only be applied as a 1st choice. (2nd choice is not permitted)
- Applicants applying for dual application (2nd choice) will need to pay an additional screening fee.
- Dual applicants must prepare the documents required by the departments to which they apply. However, only one copy is needed for educational and nationality-related documents.

3. Online Korean Language Test

- The Online Korean Language Test will only be given to successful applicants who were unable to take the TOPIK test due to COVID-19.
- If admitted students pass the Korean Language Test, it will be considered that they have met the Korean Language Standards and will be able to begin the degree program in the spring semester (March) of 2022.

4. Notes for Final Academic Certificate Submission

(For more information, please see page <04. Required Documents>.)

- Applicants are required to provide a CHSI certificate, apostille, or consular authentication on their final academic certificate by the submission deadline. Those who cannot submit it during the application period must first submit a notarized copy.
- Admitted students who were unable to provide the verified final academic certificate must submit it to the OIA in person or by post during the tuition payment period. Otherwise, the issuance of a Certificate of Admission will be restricted in accordance with Ministry of Justice regulations.

<Notice for Eligibility>

- ※ If applicants submit forged documents in regards to the eligibility requirements, the admission will be revoked, even if they have already been accepted.
- ※ If additional documents are required during the document screening process, the OIA may request them. Applicants will be held liable for any consequences resulting from providing incorrect contact information or failing to respond to the OIA on time.
- ※ Admission will be revoked if applicants fail to provide the graduation certificate.

1. Notice regarding nationality

- a. If an applicant or his/her parents have dual nationality with Korean citizenship, he/she is not considered an international student and cannot apply.
Also, if it's found after he/she is accepted, the admission will be canceled.
- b. If an applicant's family relationship needs to be confirmed (parents' divorce, remarriage, single parent, death, missing and etc.), he/she must submit authenticating documents as evidence.
ex) certificate of divorce, certificate of family relationship, certificate of single parent, certificate of death, certificate regarding missing person, confirmation of obtaining Korean citizenship etc.
※ When an applicant's single parent, who has legal custody of the applicant and is a foreign national, remarries a Korean national, the applicant must submit the Korean spouse's family relationship certificate.
- c. Acceptable period regarding the change of family relationship
 - Freshman: Those whose parents divorced or was adopted before the applicants enter high school are acceptable.
 - Transfer: Those whose parents divorced or was adopted 3-year before the application period are acceptable.

2. Notice regarding academic background

- a. Home-schooling, cyber learning, adult education, high school graduate equivalency test for self-study in Korea are not recognized as academic backgrounds.
- b. Applicants who graduated from Five-year education school in China are not acceptable.

Required Documents

<Instructions for Document Submission>

- ❶ All required documents must be submitted by the submission deadline. Applicants who are unable to submit Apostille certification or consular authentication during the application period must first submit notarized documents. However, admitted students must submit those supplementary documents according to the submission guideline. Admission may be revoked if not submitted.
- ❷ All documents must be submitted to the OIA either by post or in person. (E-mail submissions are not permitted.)
- ❸ Every document should be in A4 format and submitted in the order specified in the document submission list.
- ❹ Documents that are not written in Korean or English must be accompanied by notarized translations into either language.
- ❺ Accepted students who are expected to graduate at the time of application MUST submit their final academic certificate with Apostille certification or consular authentication. (If the document is not submitted, admission may be revoked.)
- ❻ Please contact the relevant institution for information on document verification and prepare application documents. (See Appendix 2.)
- ❼ Examples of family relationship verification document by country:

Korean Language Proficiency Standards

Satisfying Korean standards has no bearing on admissions results. Applicants who are accepted but fail the Korean Language Proficiency Test must take a leave of absence (for more information, see the leave of absence regulation) and enroll in Korean language courses at either Hanyang University Institute of International Education or language institutes of other universities. Students can re-register for the upcoming semester once they have met the Korean language requirements.

Graduation Requirements

- ▶ Undergraduate students must submit TOPIK level 4 or higher in order to graduate (English Track students are exempted).
- ▶ Regardless of admission period (spring or fall semester), freshmen must complete 8 semesters and transfer students must complete 4 semesters to graduate. (Those who registered for early graduation and met the early graduation requirements, on the other hand, are allowed to graduate early.)

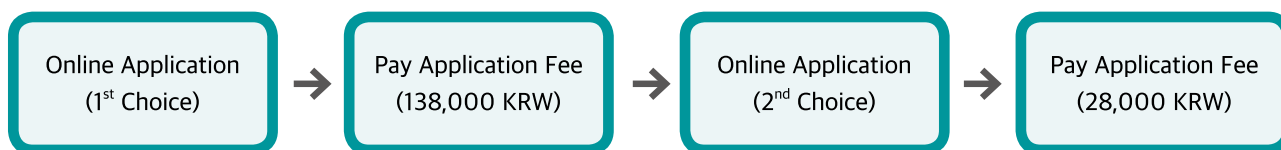
Admissions for the Seoul and ERICA campuses are managed separately, and dual applications for the 1st and 2nd choices are available for the Seoul campus. If you apply to both the Seoul and ERICA campuses and are accepted, you can only register for one of them.

A. Dual Application Criteria

- Seoul campus applicants may make a single or dual application. Only one application is allowed for Business Administration and Media & Communication majors. (They cannot be applied as 2nd Choice)

B. Dual Application Process



※ Applicants who wish to make a dual application must apply online twice. If applicants do not complete the payment of the 1st choice application fee, they cannot create a new application for the 2nd choice. (Extra transaction fee will occur if Paypal or Alipay is used)

- Dual applicants must prepare the documents required by the departments to which they apply. However, only one copy is needed for educational and nationality-related documents.

E.g 1) When applying for a major that requires document evaluation in the 1st choice and artwork screening in the 2nd choice, artwork for the 2nd choice major must be submitted.

E.g. 2) If artwork is required for both the 1st and 2nd choices of majors, artwork must be submitted separately for each.

C. Dual Application Selection

Applicants will first go through document evaluation and artwork screening for their 1st choice. Those who did not pass admission for their 1st choice will automatically be considered for admission to their 2nd choice.

D. Check the Results and Register

The results can be viewed on the OIA website by entering the applicant's application number and date of birth. Dual applicants should check the results for each application by entering the application numbers accordingly. If applicants are accepted for their 1st choice, their 2nd choice application will be automatically rejected, and they must register for their 1st choice.

Information on Document Verification

Apostille Certification and Consular Authentication

[1] Introduction for submitting a document to prove the academic history from overseas institutions

All applicants except those who have graduated in China must submit an official diploma or degree and an official academic transcript verified by one of the following verification method stated below during the designated period.

- 1) Apostilled Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript
- 2) Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript verified by a Korean Embassy

[2] Information on Apostille Convention

1. Apostille Convention

- 1) The Republic of Korea became the 90th Contracting State of the Apostille Convention (Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Document), effective as of July 14, 2007
- 2) Apostille is a certificate specifying the modalities through which a document issued in one of the signatory countries can be certified for legal purposes in all the other signatory states
- 3) Apostille convention countries abolish the complex consular procedures to ensure the mutual authentication of public and official documents (Apostilled documents have the same effect as documents verified by diplomatic offices)

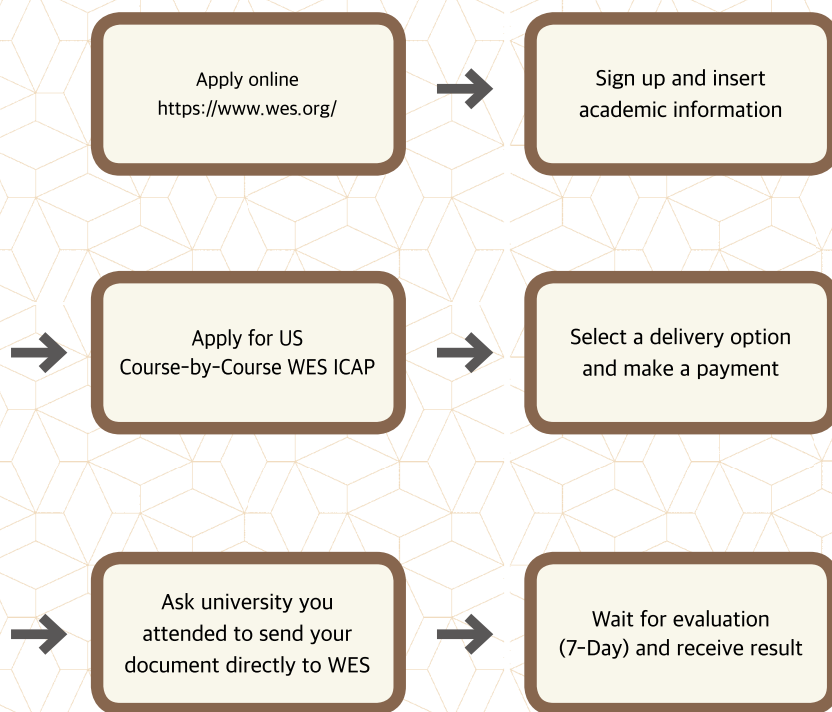
