1 Changes to Application Process of 2024 Spring Semester

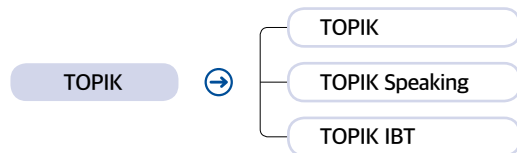

2 Expansion of Korean Language Proficiency Certification Standard

- From the Spring Semester of 2024, Korean language proficiency standards will be expanded. In addition to the existing TOPIK, TOPIK Speaking and TOPIK IBT graded will also be recognized as valid grades.

4 Guidelines for Submitting Bank Balance Certificate

- Bank balance certificate provides financial ability necessary for issuing a D2 study abroad visa, and only those who got accepted and willing to apply for D2 will be requested to submit them. Transfer	<p>1. Nationality : Applicants with foreign nationality whose parents both have foreign nationality.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applicants and their parents must have acquired foreign nationality more than 3 years prior to the application date. - If the applicants and their parents hold dual citizenship, they must both renounce their Korean citizenship three years before the application date. <p>2. Academic background : Applicants who completed at least 2 years at a four-year university at home or abroad, earning all credits required to complete 4 or more semesters (60 or more credits) (excluding summer/winter sessions) and wish to transfer to the third year (junior) in the undergraduate program.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Applicants who went to community college must graduate (with associate degree or diploma equivalent to associate degree) from the school or must be on the list of candidates for graduation. - Applicants who attended a colleges that are not officially approved by the Ministry of Education are ineligible to apply for transfer admission. Admission will be revoked if applicants do not complete at least 4 semesters at their previous university. - The students who completed (Expected)at least 2 years at three-year or five-year university. <p>3. Major : Applicants who will apply for relevant majors in Hanyang University according to their previous university's major.</p>

<Common Notice>

- ※ If applicants submit forged documents in regards to the eligibility requirements, the admission will be revoked, even if they have already been accepted.
- ※ If additional documents are required during the document screening process, the OIA may request them. Applicants will be held liable for any consequences resulting from providing incorrect contact information or failing to respond to the OIA on time.
- ※ Admission will be revoked if applicants fail to provide the graduation certificate.

1. Notice regarding nationality

- a. If an applicant or his/her parents have dual nationality with Korean citizenship, he/she is not considered an international student and cannot apply.
Also, if it's found after he/she is accepted, the admission will be canceled.
- b. If an applicant's family relationship needs to be confirmed (parents' divorce, remarriage, single parent, death, missing and etc.), he/she must submit authenticating documents as evidence.
 - ex) certificate of divorce, certificate of family relationship, certificate of single parent, certificate of death, certificate regarding missing person, confirmation of obtaining Korean citizenship etc.
 - ※ When an applicant's single parent, who has legal custody of the applicant and is a foreign national, remarries a Korean national, the applicant must submit the Korean spouse's family relationship certificate.
 - ※ (only for Chinese nationals) Death certificates can be substituted with one of the following documentation.
 - ㉠ Original Notarized Cancellation of Registration Certificate
 - ㉡ Original Notarized Family Certificate verifies the death
- c. Acceptable period regarding the change of family relationship
 - Freshman : Those whose family relationship has changed before the applicants enter high school are acceptable.
 - Transfer : Those whose family relationship has changed 3-years before the application period are acceptable.

2. Notice regarding academic background

- a. Home-schooling, cyber learning, adult education, high school graduate equivalency test for self-study in Korea are not recognized as academic backgrounds.
- b. Applicants who graduated from Five-year education school in China are not acceptable.

<Instructions for Document Submission>

- ① All required documents must be submitted by the guided submission deadline.
 - ※ However, owing to unavoidable circumstances, applicants who are unable to submit Apostille certification, consular authentication and other extra documents during the application period must submit those supplementary documents after the result announcement.
 - ※ The disadvantage of not following the above instructions is the responsibility of the students.
- ② All documents must be submitted to the OIA either by post or in person.
- ③ Every document should be in A4 format and submitted in the order specified in the document submission list.
- ④ Documents that are not written in Korean or English must be accompanied by notarized translations into either language, if the applicant has problem with notarized translation please contact to the admission office.
- ⑤ Accepted students who are expected to graduate at the time of application MUST submit their final academic certificate with Apostille certification or consular authentication. (If the document is not submitted, admission may be revoked.)
- ⑥ Please contact the relevant institution for information on document verification and prepare application documents. (See Appendix 2.)
- ⑦ Examples of family relationship verification document by country:

- ⑩ ALL submitted documents including supporting materials will NOT be returned to the applicants. We advise applicants to prepare additional documentation for visa applications.

07 Korean Language Proficiency Standards

Applicants' scholastic ability is prioritized when it comes to evaluation. Even the applicants who do not satisfy Korean standards can be accepted by Hanyang University based on their scholastic competence. However, if applicants who are accepted but did not satisfy the Korean language standards, must take a leave of absence till the standard is satisfied, and then re-register to start degree courses.

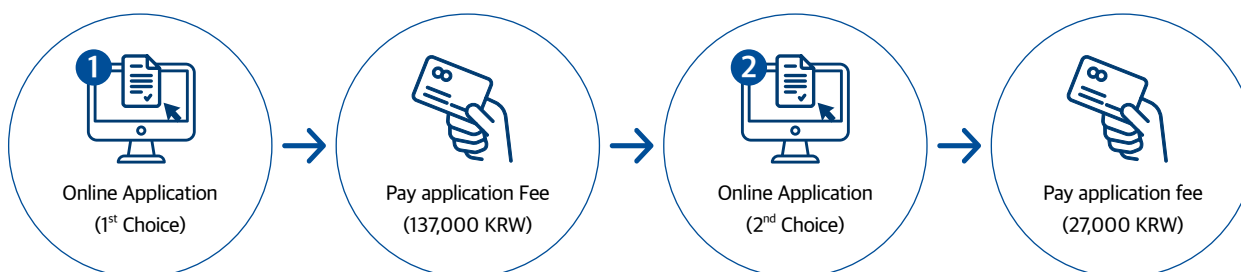
Admissions for the Seoul and ERICA campuses are managed separately, and dual applications for the 1st and 2nd choices are available for the Seoul Campus. If you apply to both the Seoul and ERICA campuses and are accepted, you can only register for one of them.

A. Dual Application Criteria

Seoul Campus applicants may make a single or dual application. Only one application is allowed for Business Administration(Korean Track, English Track) and Media & Communication majors. (They cannot be applied as 2nd Choice)

B. Dual Application Process



※ Applicants who wish to make a dual application must apply online twice. If applicants do not complete the payment of the 1st choice application fee, they cannot create a new application for the 2nd choice. (Extra transaction fee will occur if Paypal or Alipay is used)

Dual applicants must prepare the documents required by the departments to which they apply. However, only one copy is needed for educational and nationality-related documents.

E.g 1 When applying for a major that requires document evaluation in the 1st choice and artwork screening in the 2nd choice, artwork for the 2nd choice major must be submitted.

E.g 2 If artwork is required for both the 1st and 2nd choices of majors, artwork must be submitted separately for each.

C. Dual Application Selection

Applicants will first go through document evaluation and artwork screening for their 1st choice. Those who did not pass admission for their 1st choice will automatically be considered for admission to their 2nd choice.

D. Check the Results and Register

The results can be viewed on the OIA website by entering the applicant's application number and date of birth. Dual applicants should check the results for each application by entering the application numbers accordingly. If applicants are accepted for their 1st choice, their 2nd choice application will be automatically rejected, and they must register for their 1st choice.

Apostille Certification and Consular Authentication

1 Introduction for submitting a document to prove the academic history from overseas institutions

All applicants except those who have graduated in China must submit an official diploma or degree and an official academic transcript verified by one of the following verification method stated below during the designated period.

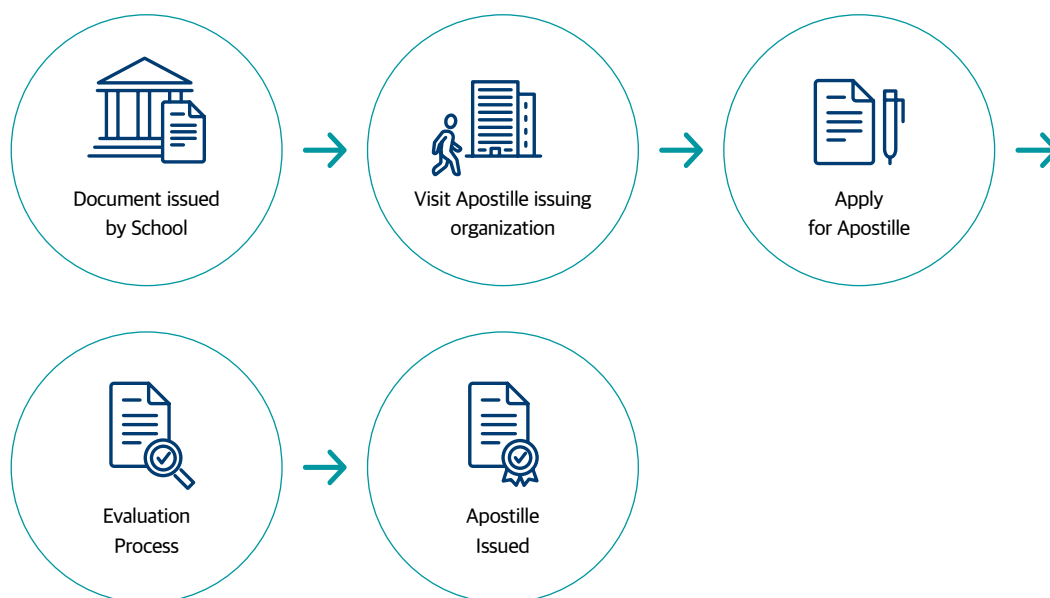
1. Apostilled Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript
2. Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript verified by a Korean Embassy

2 Information on Apostille Convention

1. Apostille Convention

- 1) The Republic of Korea became the 90th Contracting State of the Apostille Convention (Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Document), effective as of July 14, 2007
 - 2) Apostille is a certificate specifying the modalities through which a document issued in one of the signatory countries can be certified for legal purposes in all the other signatory states
 - 3) Apostille convention countries abolish the complex consular procedures to ensure the mutual authentication of public and official documents (Apostilled documents have the same effect as documents verified by diplomatic offices)
2. Apostille Convention is an international treaty drafted by the Hague Conference on Private International Law: You can check out detailed updated information regarding regional authorities at www.hcch.net

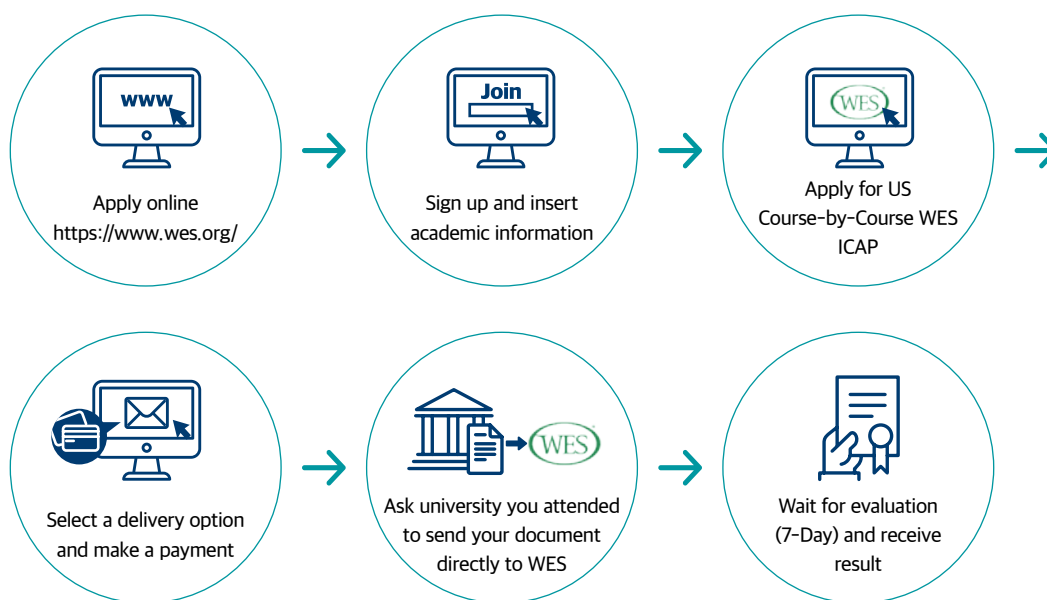
