



- \*\* There is no Interview Examination done by the International Admissions Team, but each department/major may conduct an interview if necessary.

## ■ Korean Proficiency Requirements for Graduate Admission

An admitted student who fails to achieve at least one of the Korean requirements must take a leave of absence. After achieving one, the student may request a return to start taking regular courses.

\* The maximum period for leave of absence is based on the university's policy

- B. Scholarship period: Master 4 semesters / Ph.D 4 semesters / MA-Ph.D 6 semesters (excluding extended study period and research registration)
- C. Requirement: Scholarship recipients must achieve a minimum of 3.0 GPA each semester in order to retain their scholarship.

#### Hanyang Alumni Scholarship

Hanyang Alumni Scholarship is awarded to international students who graduated from Hanyang University degree program.

- A. Benefit: 50% reduction in tuition and 50% reduction in admission fee
- B. Scholarship period: Master 4 semesters / Ph.D 4 semesters / MA-Ph.D 6 semesters (excluding extended study period and research registration)
- C. Requirement: Scholarship recipients must achieve a minimum of 3.0 GPA each semester in order to retain this scholarship.
- \* Those who don't submit Certificate of graduation from Hanyang University cannot be awarded Hanyang Alumni Scholarship.

#### • GSIS (Seoul), Industrial Convergence (ERICA) scholarship for international students

This scholarship is awarded to international students who get accepted to the Graduate School of International Studies (Seoul) and Industrial Convergence (ERICA).

#### A. Benefit:

- Graduate School of International Studies: 20% reduction in tuition
- Graduate School of Industrial Convergence: 30% reduction in tuition
- B. Scholarship period: Master 4 semesters / Ph.D 4 semesters (excluding extended study period and research registration)
- C. Requirement: Scholarship recipients must achieve a minimum of 3.0 GPA each semester in order to retain their scholarship.

#### Hanyang Bridge Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to international students who have participated in exchange or visiting program at Hanyang University.

- A. Benefit: 50% reduction in tuition

- \* Must submit supporting documents (certificate/transcript) to prove on the participation in Hanvang Exchange or visiting program.

#### • Hanyang Scholarship for Excellence in Language Proficiency - Graduate

Hanyang Scholarship for Excellence in Language Proficiency is awarded to applicants who have passed the TOPIK level 5 or 6, or achieved a TOEFL iBT score of 90 or higher or IELTS score of 6.5 or higher.

#### Hanyang International Excellence Awards (HIEA) - ERICA

- HIEA is awarded to international students who have achieved notable academic progress at Hanyang University.
  - A. Qualification: Students with a valid TOPIK level certificate of any level and Insurance who achieved a minimum GPA of 4.0 out of 4.5 in the previous semester
  - B. Recipients are selected by documents screening. Recipients will receive 100%, 70%, 50% or 30% tuition reduction according to their evaluation results.
  - C. Scholarship period: One semester
  - D. Required Documents: to be announced at OIA website
  - E. Caution: Korean nationals are not eligible

#### TOPIK Scholarship (Seoul)

- A. Application requirements
  - ① International student enrolled in a degree program at Seoul Campus that have obtained a TOPIK certificate after enrollment(Korean nationals are not eligible)

# **Apostille Certification and Consular Authentication**

# 1 Introduction for submitting a document to prove the academic history from overseas institutions


All applicants except those who have graduated in China must submit an official diploma or degree and an official academic transcript verified by one of the following verification method stated below during the designated period.

- 1. Apostilled Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript
- 2. Official diploma or degree and official academic transcript verified by a Korean Embassy

## 2 Information on Apostille Convention

- 1. Apostille Convention
  - 1) The Republic of Korea became the 90<sup>th</sup> Contracting State of the Apostille Convention (Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Document), effective as of July 14, 2007
  - 2) Apostille is a certificate specifying the modalities through which a document issued in one of the signatory countries can be certified for legal purposes in all the other signatory states
  - 3) Apostille convention countries abolish the complex consular procedures to ensure the mutual authentication of public and official documents (Apostilled documents have the same effect as documents verified by diplomatic offices)
- 2. Apostille Convention is an international treaty drafted by the Hague Conference on Private International Law: You can check out detailed updated information regarding regional authorities at www.hcch.net


